WHY is it essential to be SURE of your MOVE to your eternal destination IN

ADVANCE? Because Heaven is only one of the two places of eternal destination people will be in... *FOREVER*.

While Heaven is wonderful and beautiful beyond anything we've ever seen, heard or even imagined, the other place, Hell... will be HORRIBLE almost beyond description.

Jesus taught and warned about Hell. In Matthew 25:41 & 46, He said it was *"Everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels"* but unsaved people would also be there in *"everlasting punishment."* There is a *"great gulf fixed"* that will prevent people from ever leaving Hell. *(Luke 16:26)* Can you imagine the HORROR of being in Hell with NO HOPE of <u>ever</u> getting out?

BUT... THERE IS GOOD NEWS! God has made provision for our salvation, so we can have solid HOPE and ASSURANCE of Heaven based on His written Word.

If you are CONCERNED about your salvation and future MOVE to eternity (somewhere), that CONCERN is a good indication God is calling you to Himself. "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son (Jesus) that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not His son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved. He that believeth on Him (Jesus) is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God" (John 3:6-18).

What will you do about Jesus? This alone will determine the eternal destination of your FUTURE MOVE from life on Earth to Heaven or... Hell forever.
